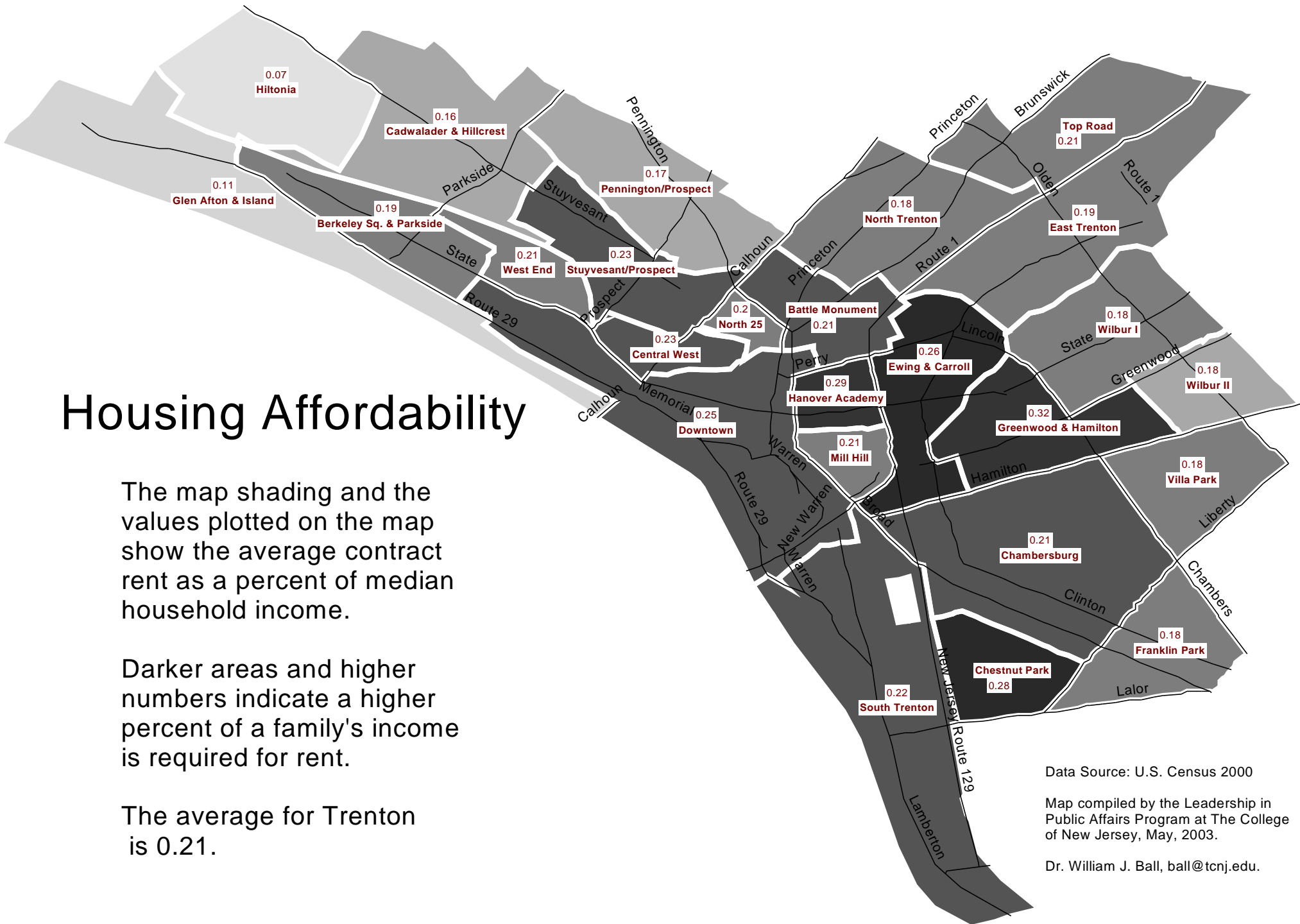


# Housing Affordability

The map shading and the values plotted on the map show the average contract rent as a percent of median household income.

Darker areas and higher numbers indicate a higher percent of a family's income is required for rent.

The average for Trenton is 0.21.
