



# Voting in Trenton

## Political Participation in the 2000 Election

Precincts are outlined in red boundaries. Within each precinct is a label indicating the percent of registered voters who voted in the 2000 election (turnout), the total number of registered voters, the ward and the precinct. Thus "45/326 E23" would indicate 45% turnout of 326 registered voters in the East ward, precinct 23.

Shaded areas indicate the number of people over 18 in the census block. The darker the shading, the more people (see the legend to the right). Blocks with no population or missing data are white.
