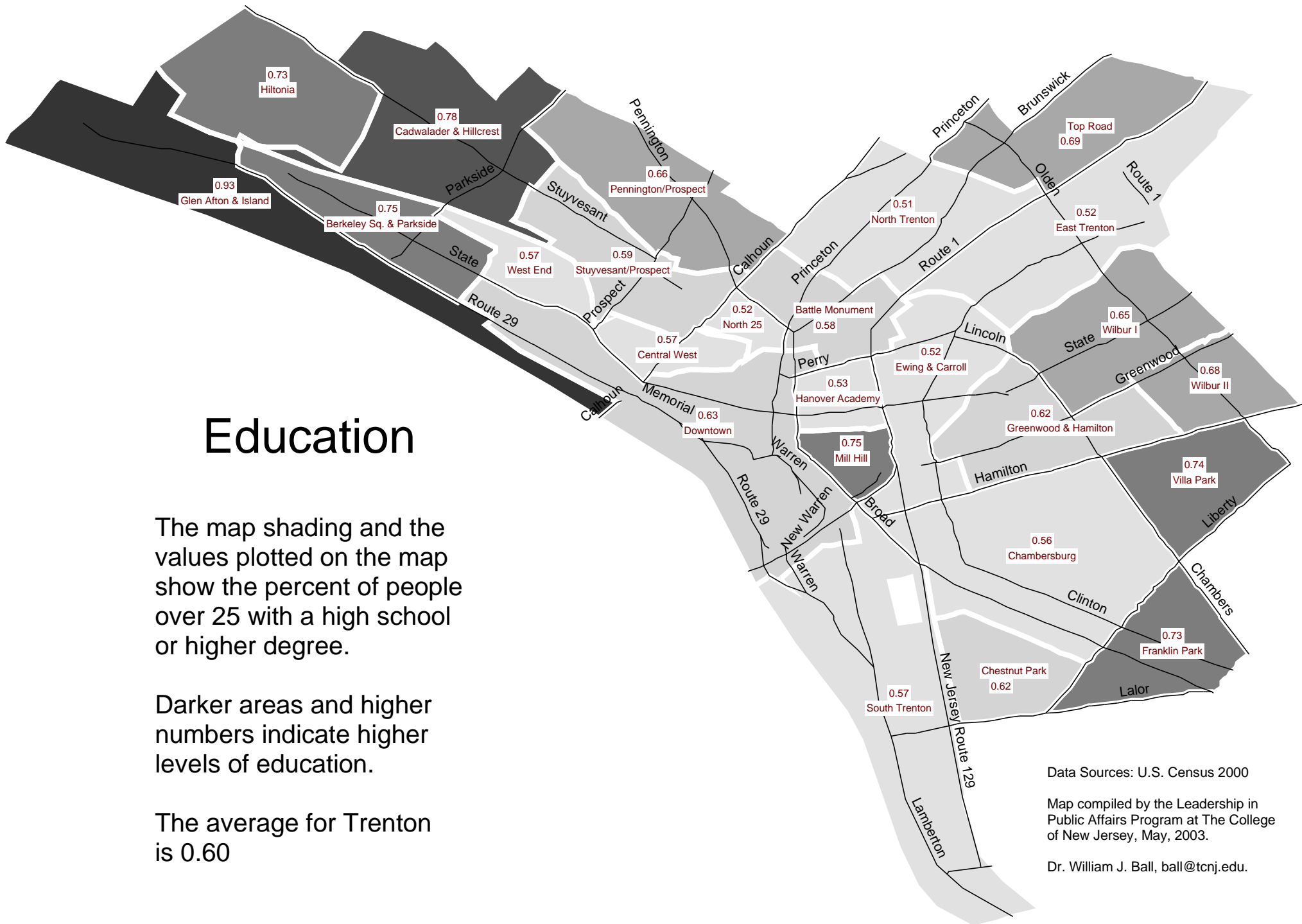


Education

Darker areas and higher numbers indicate higher levels of education.
