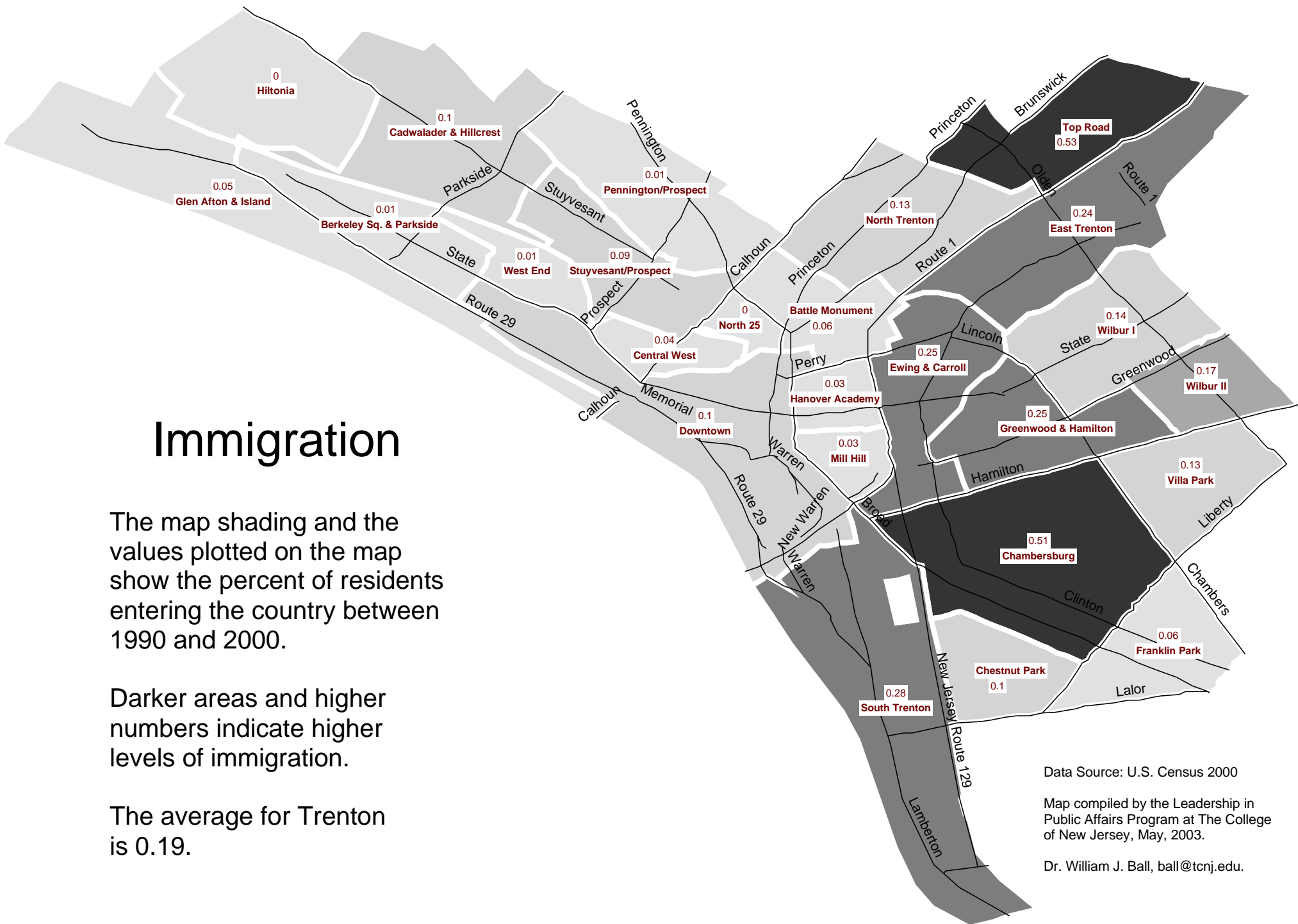


Immigration

The map shading and the values plotted on the map show the percent of residents entering the country between 1990 and 2000.

Darker areas and higher numbers indicate higher levels of immigration.

The average for Trenton is 0.19.
