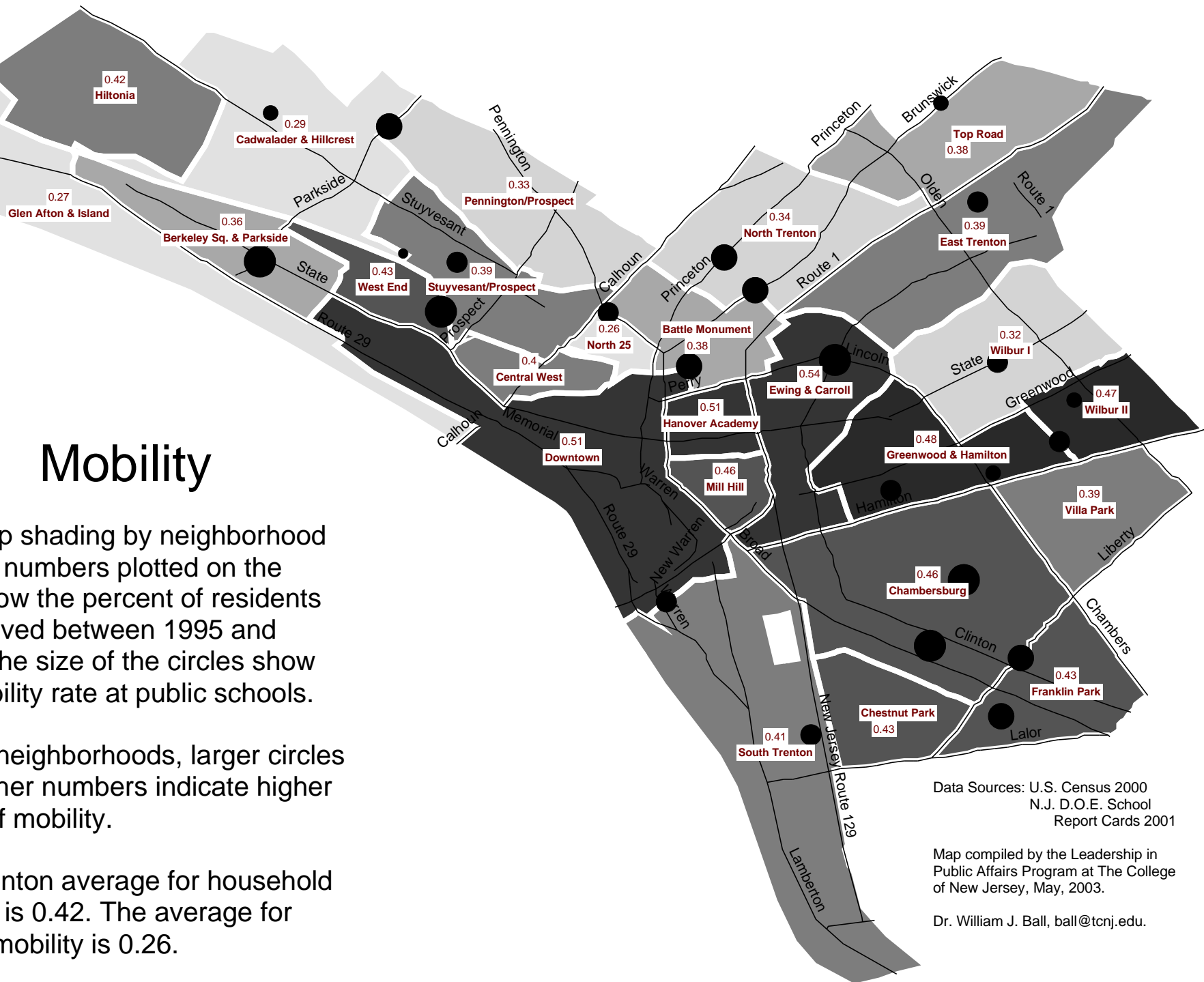


Mobility

The map shading by neighborhood and the numbers plotted on the map show the percent of residents who moved between 1995 and 2000. The size of the circles show the mobility rate at public schools.

Darker neighborhoods, larger circles and higher numbers indicate higher levels of mobility.

The Trenton average for household mobility is 0.42. The average for school mobility is 0.26.
