

Public Safety and Population Density

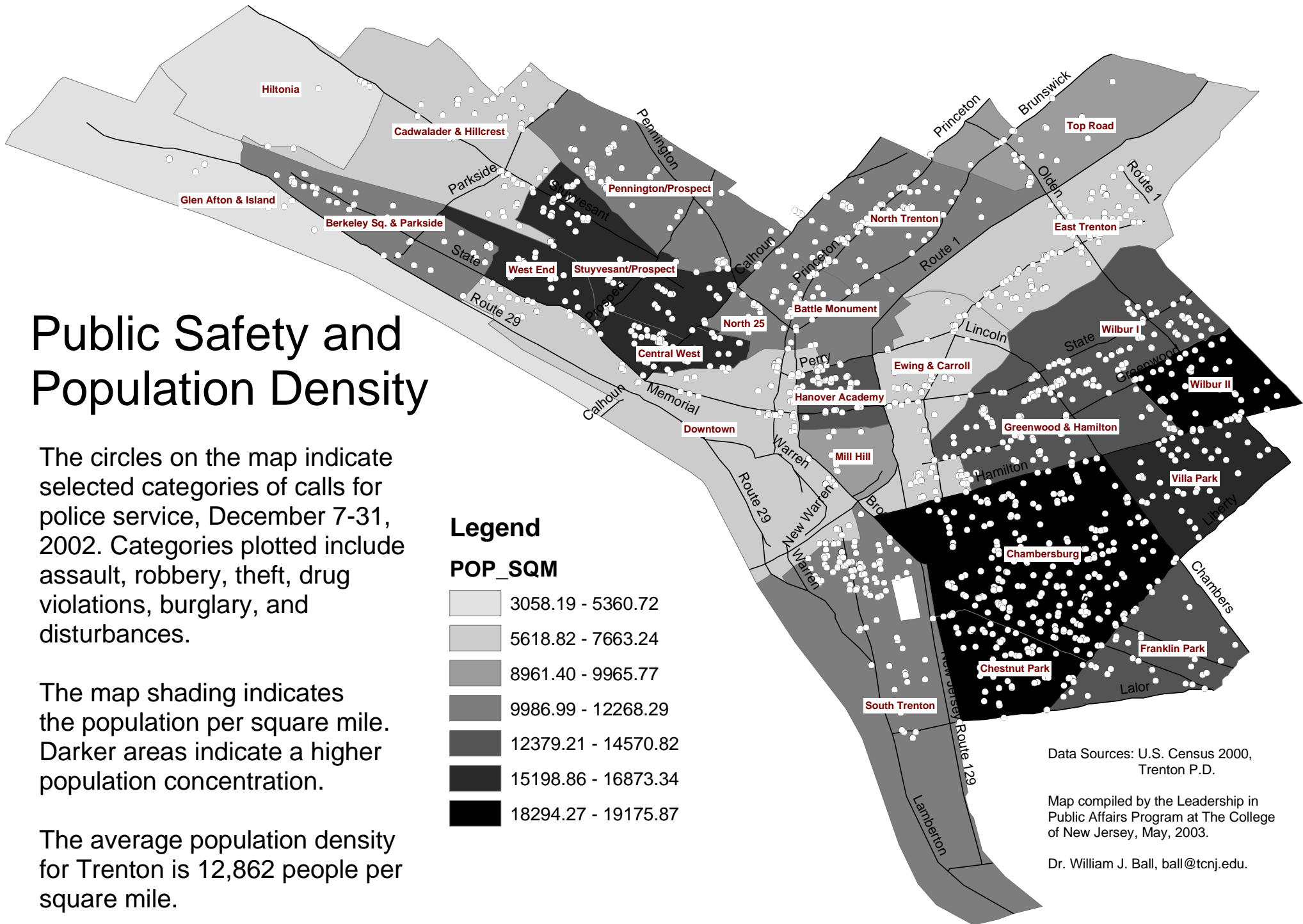
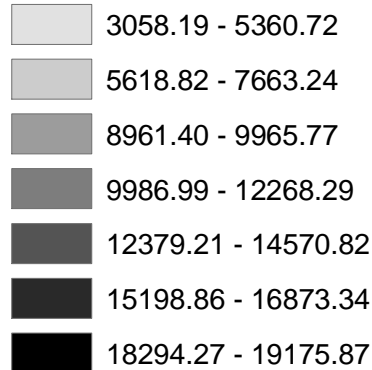
The circles on the map indicate selected categories of calls for police service, December 7-31, 2002. Categories plotted include assault, robbery, theft, drug violations, burglary, and disturbances.

The map shading indicates the population per square mile. Darker areas indicate a higher population concentration.

The average population density for Trenton is 12,862 people per square mile.
